Blizzard Response: Resident Update #1

The National Weather Service has issued a Blizzard Warning for the New York City area, including Scarsdale. During the overnight hours tonight and continuing into Tuesday, the Village anticipates receiving between 12" and 18" of snow, with wind gusts potentially reaching 50 mph. If a local State of Emergency is declared, residents will be notified through Blackboard Connect, the village-wide emergency notification system, with special regulations related to parking and traffic implemented, accompanied by any other necessary public safety measures.

The following decisions have already been made in preparation for the winter storm:

- The Village Board Finance Committee and Regular Village Board meetings scheduled for Tuesday, March 14th, at 6:30 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., respectively, have been rescheduled for the same times on Wednesday, March 15th;
- Sanitation collection for Tuesday, March 14th, has been canceled. The Tuesday collection will occur on Friday, March 17th;
- The Wednesday, March 15th, recycling collection is currently planned to occur, but will be curbside only;
- The Scarsdale Public Library will be closed on Tuesday, March 14th;
- The Recycling Yard will remain open until 8:00 p.m. tonight, Monday, March 13th, for residents wishing to drop-off waste or recycling ahead of the winter storm;
- The Freightway Garage rooftop levels 5A and 5B will be closed and barricaded tonight at 11:00 p.m. to facilitate snow plowing operations; and
- Residents are reminded of the existing overnight parking prohibition on any village street or open/surface parking lot between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Effective at 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 14th, the Village will deploy a "Snow Desk" for residents to call for non-emergency, snow-related issues or concerns. The phone number is 914-722-1150. Although the Village may experience reduced staffing, normal Village Hall operating hours are expected this week, including tomorrow, Tuesday, March 14th.

Please check on the well-being of family, friends, and neighbors during and after the anticipated blizzard.
