Storm-Related Local State of Emergency Rescinded

Effective immediately, the local storm-related State of Emergency has been rescinded. Local travel is authorized to resume. However, it is important to note that downed trees, wires, and related road closures remain present in various locations in the Village. Residents should use *extreme caution* around downed trees and wires, assuming that any such conditions include dangerous electrical hazards. Also, it is important for drivers to note that a non-functioning traffic light serves as a mandatory stop sign, whether a stop sign is posted or not.

A press release including a list of current road closures will soon be available online from www.scarsdale.com, on the home page under the News Flash heading at the bottom. Power has just been restored to Village Hall and the building will be open during normal business hours tomorrow, Monday, and for all evening meetings. The Superintendent of Schools has informed me of his intent to open Scarsdale Public Schools tomorrow and will send a separate notice to all residents to this effect. Monday sanitation collections are planned as scheduled; however, based on the current road closures crews will not be able to reach all homes. Missed collections will be picked up on Tuesday, March 6, or the next available collection day based on the continuing road and power restoration work. No changes to the balance of this week's sanitation schedule are anticipated.

Con Ed reports that 200 mutual aid crews are arriving in Westchester in time to begin power restorations in earnest tomorrow, Monday. Con Ed's stated goal is to have power restored to 90% of all Westchester customers by Tuesday night, March 6. Restorations are prioritized based on the volume of outages at any particular location. Con Edison can be reached at 1-800-752-6633 regarding individual property restoration status. Status can also be checked on Con Ed's website outage map at www.coned.com. Residents should note that the Scarsdale Public Library will maintain extended operating hours of 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM, beginning tomorrow, Monday, March 5, and lasting until further notice. Residents without heat and electricity can warm up and charge their cell phones at the Library.

State of Emergency Rescission

At 5:30 PM on March 2, 2018, I, Stephen M. Pappalardo, as Village Manager of the Village of Scarsdale exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law, to declare a State of Emergency in the Village of Scarsdale due to the emergency conditions resulting from the Nor'easter storm.

As emergency conditions have been significantly remedied, the State of Emergency is no longer warranted. As such, the Village of Scarsdale is no longer in a State of Emergency and the prohibition of vehicular and pedestrian travel and parking is hereby rescinded.

Please be advised that the following roads or parts thereof remain closed due to downed trees with associated electrical lines. Please steer clear of these roadways until further notice.
