Storm Update: 10:30 AM

Please continue to exercise extreme caution around any downed trees or electric wires. Residents should assume that an electrical hazard is present. Additional [storm safety tips](#) are available from www.coned.com. Please make sure friends and neighbors are signed-up for [Notify Me](#) and have updated their contact information in the Village's emergency robo-call system, [Blackboard Connect](#).

The [latest National Weather Service briefing](#) indicates that the impending major winter storm has shifted 20-40 miles to the southeast, thereby increasing the anticipated potential snow totals throughout the region. Locally, accumulation in the 4" to 12" range is forecasted, with up to 20" anticipated for the Lower Hudson Valley and areas beyond. The snow will be accompanied by sustained winds in the 15-30 mph range with gusts of 25-55mph. These conditions increase the threat of additional downed trees and electric wires, as well as the associated power outages. Restoration status can also be checked online through [ConEd's Outage Map](#).

Residents should make [immediate preparations](#) for a significant winter storm event.

As of this morning, ConEd is reporting that 444 electric outages remain from the 1,420 reported yesterday. Two ConEd restoration crews are in the Village at this time in support of the local response and recovery effort. Only one road remains closed at this time, Oak Lane; removing the tree causing that closure requires temporarily cutting power to the surrounding homes. ConEd restoration crews are scheduled to perform this work today, weather permitting.

Based on the snow forecast, Village Public Works crews will be plowing snow from Village roadways all day and into tonight. Residents are asked to not park on the streets unless necessary due to property access issues arising from downed trees or wires. All discretionary travel should be avoided, and residents are cautioned to drive safely when venturing onto local roads.

All meetings at Village Hall this evening have been canceled, and we will be operating with reduced staffing.
