Storm Update: 10:40 AM

Heavy snows and winds during the overnight hours have resulted in new road closures and a variety of new hazards, including downed trees, downed electric wires, and low-hanging wires.

As of this morning, Con Ed is tracking 1,660 customer outages in Scarsdale, which have resulted from 112 discrete events, representing a sharp increase over yesterday's remaining outage count of 444. The Village continues to pressure ConEd to step-up their restoration efforts, having engaged both County and New York State officials to assist in that regard. Outages already reported can be tracked using the ConEd [Outage Map](#), also available online at www.ConEd.com. Residents should prepare for outages that may continue into the weekend, perhaps longer if ConEd is not responsive to our urgent needs.

Please continue to exercise extreme caution around any downed trees or electric wires. Residents should assume that an electrical hazard is present. Please make sure friends and neighbors are signed-up for [Notify Me](#) and have updated their contact information in the Village's emergency robo-call system, [Blackboard Connect](#).

Below is a list of storm-related road closures in effect at this time. The list is fluid, as new problems may be encountered and others may be cleared as our work continues.

1. Brewster Road (Huntington Ave – Kingston Road)
2. Brite Avenue (Huntington – Kingston)
3. Carman Road (Gaylor – Bell).
4. Claremont Road (Berkeley Road – Walworth Ave)
5. Crossway (Lincoln Road – Firehouse)
6. Eton Road (Greendale – Windmill)
7. Penn Blvd (Swarthmore – Franklin)
8. Popham Road – West bound lane closed at Home
9. Post Road, but opening soon (Burgess Road – Olmsted Road)
